**DIVISION LEVEL SEARCH FOR BEST VALEDICTORY ADDRESS FOR GRADES 6
AND 12 AND BEST MOVING-UP SPEECH FOR GRADE 10**

This Division

1. To recognize the potentials and learning abilities of the graduates and completers with honors, a Division Level Search for Best Valedictory Address in Grades 6 and 12 and Best Moving-up Speech in Grade 10 shall be conducted on April 30, 2018 at the Function Hall I, Tangub City.
2. The Search which is a joint undertaking of the Division of Tangub City and the Local Government Unit of Tangub (LGU) is part of the Tangub REWARDS Program.
3. Identified top honor completers in Grade 10, top honor graduates in Grade 12 and top three winners in Grade 6 in every District during the first round contest shall qualify to participate in the Division level contest.
4. Grades 6 and 10 contestants shall wear complete school uniform including ID while Grade 12 contenders shall wear the prescribed toga.
5. Contest guidelines, criteria and the list of winners in the elementary level for the search are attached.
6. Relative to this, a dry-run and orientation shall be scheduled on April 27, 2018 at 1:00 in the afternoon at the Function Hall I to have a smooth and organized conduct of the contest.
7. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

Guidelines and Criteria of Tangub REWARDS Best Valedictory Address for Grades 6 and 12 and Best Moving Up Speech for Grade 10

1. The search is open to all Grade 6 top honor graduates who are top three winners in the District level first round Search, Grade 10 top honor completers in Junior high schools and top honor graduates of the first batch of Senior High School for the SY 2017-2018.
2. The masterpiece (valedictory address/moving up speech) must be a memorized discourse or speech and shall be delivered in English.
3. The speech shall depict the theme of this year's Graduation Rites/Moving-up Ceremony **"Mag-aaral ng K to 12: Handa sa Hamon ng Buhay (K to 12 Learners Ready to Face Life's Challenges)"**.
4. The time limit for delivery shall be a minimum of three (3) minutes and a maximum of five (5) minutes only.
5. A one-point deduction shall be made for every minute excess of time.
6. Top three winners from each District in Grade 6 category shall qualify in the Division level of competition but the board of judges shall proclaim top five who will receive cash incentives.
7. For Grade 10, each school shall send a contestant who ranks first among the completers representing every Curriculum or Special Program. However, there's only one representative/contestant from each school for the Grade 12 Senior High School regardless the number of tracks offered.
8. Top five (5) winners in Grades 6, 10 and 12 respectively shall be proclaimed right after the Division level contest.
9. The winners will receive cash incentives, medals and Certificates of Recognition courtesy of the Local Government Unit of Tangub City.
10. It is a must that all Division level qualifiers shall submit to the Division Office three (3) hard copies of their original contest pieces to be placed in long folders three days before the conduct of the contest. Non-compliance on this particular guideline will mean disqualification from joining the actual level contest.
11. On the contest day, the judges will review and pre-judge the written speeches of the contestants an hour before the actual oral contest.
12. During the actual delivery in both District and Division levels, the contestants (top honor graduates/completers) shall be rated based on the following criteria:

a) Relevance to the Theme	30%
b) Organization of Speech (coherence, emphasis and unity of ideas)	30%
c) Voice Quality and Enunciation	20%
d) Delivery (Confidence, Convincing, Stage Presence)	<u>20%</u>
Total	100%
13. The decision of the panel of judges is final and un-appealable.
