**PARTICIPATION TO THE UPCOMING BOY SCOUTS OF THE

1. Scouting with the Boy Scouts of the Philippines (BSP) is an effective co-curricular program in the leadership and value formation of every child. Its main objective is consistent with the Department of Education's mission to develop every boy and every young man into well-rounded individual with exemplary character worth the emulation of school children. The BSP has consistently produced leaders and role models who are true advocates of the Scout Oath and Law.
2. With its impressive track record on youth development, the Department of Education (DepEd) recognizes the significant role of the BSP in aiding the school system mold pupils and students into responsible and responsive citizens of the country and in contributing to efforts to achieve quality education. As a co-curricular program, Scouting helps stem away vices and bad influences of drugs and peers. As such, membership and participation in Boy Scouting and its programs, projects and activities should be highly encouraged and supported in the schools as per D.O. 76, s. 2012.

To strengthen quality scouting program and pursuant to the approved 2018 BSP Misamis Occidental Council Calendar of Activities, **this office calls for teacher participants** to the upcoming BSP Basic Training Course for KAWAN (for Kinder to Grade 3), TROOP (for Grade 4 to Grade 6), OUTFIT ADVISERS (for Junior High School) and ROVER VIGIL (for Senior High School) starting on June 22, 2018, 1:00 O'clock in the afternoon to June 24, 2018 at Maloro Integrated School, Maloro, Tangub City.
4. The registration fee is 1,000.00 pesos to cover honorariums to the Leader Trainers, certificates, T-shirts, and foods (6 meals and 4 snacks) during the duration of the training and may be charged to school scouting funds, PTA funds, funds sourced from other stakeholders/ personal funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
