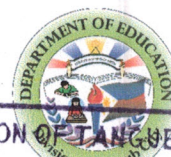
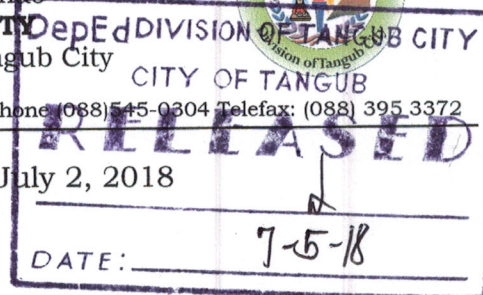

REITERATION OF NO COLLECTION POLICY



1. This Office reiterates DepEd Memorandum No. 143, s. 2016 dated September 2, 2016 entitled Reiteration of No Collection Policy from the Parents-Teachers Association and DepEd Order No. 41 s, 2012 entitled No Collection Policy which consistently remind all personnel in public elementary and secondary schools nationwide to refrain from imposing and collecting "compulsory" contributions among their students.

2. This No Collection Policy however, includes the implementing policies on the collection of voluntary school contributions such as Boy Scouts of the Philippines (BSP), Girl Scouts of the Philippines (GSP), Anti-TB Fund Drive, Parents-Teachers Association (PTA), and School Publication Fee. Meanwhile, the maximum contribution per learner for BSP and GSP is P50.00, P30.00 for the PNR and P5.00 for the Anti-TB Fund Drive. Furthermore, to promote the journalism program, it is stressed that collection of publication fee (though not mandatory) would not be more than Sixty Pesos (P60) from the elementary pupils and not more than Ninety Pesos (P90) from the secondary students. Schools collecting publication fee are expected to release their school paper.

3. Thus, all DepEd issuances pertaining to collection of fees and /or contributions shall strictly be on VOLUNTARY bases and shall be undertaken by the PTA which is recognized by the school. No DepEd personnel shall receive any of these voluntary contributions.

4. Immediate dissemination and compliance of this Memorandum is desired.
