

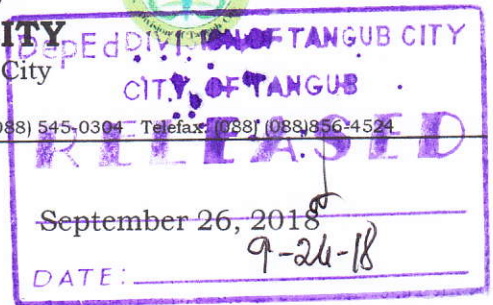

**ENHANCEMENT TRAINING FOR RSPC INDIVIDUAL WRITING QUALIFIERS
AND PAGE DESIGN AND LAY-OUTING OF SCHOOL PAPERS**

1. In preparation for the coming Regional Schools Press Conference (RSPC), this Office, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) in coordination with the LGU of Tangub City conducts a level up training on new trends and updates in campus journalism for Regional Schools Press Conference (RSPC) individual writing events and page design and lay-outing.
2. The Enhancement Training shall be conducted in two rounds as seen in Table 1 below;

3. The participants of this level up training are the following:

- a. For Round 1, school paper advisers in elementary, school paper advisers and lay-out artists in the secondary schools, identified school paper advisers and lay-out artists of NMSCST and GADTC who shall work for the enhancement of the lay-outing and page design of the publications for the regional and national group contests; and
 - b. For Round 2, school paper advisers, coaches and campus journalists who are qualifiers in the Regional Schools Press Conference (RSPC).
4. Participants shall bring laptop, extension wire, pocket wifi, soft and hard copy of the recent school publication, articles and photos for the one-on-one enhancement on lay-outing and page make up.
 5. Meals and snacks for the participants shall be served for free.
 6. Honoraria, accommodation and travel expenses for the resource persons and food for the participants and resource persons shall be charged against LGU funds while travel expenses and other incidental expenses of the participants shall be charged against school MOOE/publication funds/local funds subject to usual accounting and auditing policies, rules and regulations.
 7. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
