CONDUCT OF TANGUB REWARDS' POETIC JOUST CONTEST FOR GRADE 11

1. This Office informs the field of the final schedule of the conduct of the poetic joust/spoken word poetry contest as part of the annual Tangub REWARDS searches.
2. The competition shall be held on January 12, 2018, Friday at 8:00 in the morning at the Division Office Conference Hall.
3. This contest which is open to Grade 11 Senior High School students both public and private in this Division aims to;
 - a) encourage and inspire learners to work for exemplary academic performance
 - b) raise reading performance and master oral fluency skills of the learners
4. Guidelines and criteria for judging are found in the enclosure.
5. Relative to this contest, a meeting of coach-trainers shall take place on January 10, 2018 at 3:00 PM at the Division Conference Hall to create Technical Working Group (TWG) on the conduct of the contest.
6. Travel and incidental expenses of the participants shall be charged against School MOOE/local funds subject to usual accounting and auditing policies, rules and regulations.
7. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum is desired.

Guidelines, Mechanics and Criteria of the Contest

1. Each participating school must send two winning pairs for every class or section for the Division level contest.
2. The pair may consist of either male and female, or a both male/female.
3. The pair shall use the official contest piece (Man, Woman) in the actual performance which was given in November last year
4. Each pair should have memorized the contest piece beforehand.
5. Top five winners shall be announced right after the judging, deliberation of the judges and consolidation of results.
6. The winners shall receive certificates, medals and cash incentives from the LGU of Tanguib City and these shall be awarded in the occasion of the 2018 Closing Exercises/Commencement Exercises of the winning schools.
7. The decision of the board of judges is final and unappealable.
8. The following are the **criteria** for judging:
 - a) **Physical Appearance**- 20 points
 - b) **Body Language** - 20 points
 - c) **Voice** (Articulation, Projection, Intonation, Pitch and Pace- 20 points
 - d) **Understanding** (Interpretation, Internalization)- 30 points
 - e) **Over-all Performance**-10 points

Total – 100 points
