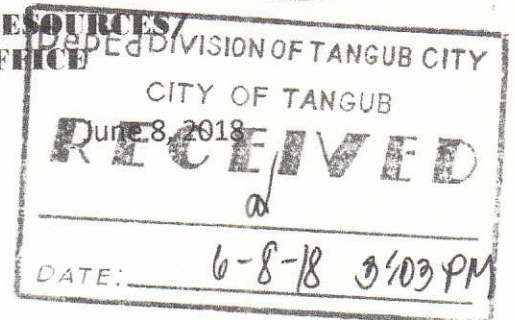

Greetings!

This is with reference to the city's Solid Waste Management (SWM) program implementation pursuant to the provisions of **R.A. No. 9003**, otherwise known as "**The Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000**" and **City Ordinance No. 2014-09-0019**, also known as "**The Comprehensive Solid Waste Management of Tangub City**". Please be informed that pursuant to the provisions of these laws, the schools (public and private) are mandated to establish their respective Material Recovery Facilities (MRFs) and exercise proper waste segregation, collection, storage, and recovery.

As per policy of the City Solid Waste Management Board (CSWMB) chaired by the City Mayor, all schools are required to submit their respective SWM plans, programs, and activities to this office and to comply with the provisions of the law. Our office is conducting random monitoring to the schools in our city re: compliance to the SWM program based on the letter sent to your office last July 5, 2017.

We are willing to provide technical assistance to your schools, if you find it necessary, in framing up their SWM plans and implementation activities that will complement to the national and local government's call towards environmental protection and conservation.
