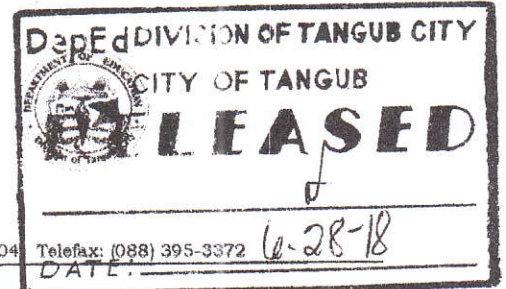

REITERATING THE CONDUCT OF MONTHLY SCHOOL LEARNING ACTION CELL

1. Per Division Memorandum No. 35, s. 2018 entitled “Synchronized Friday Activities” which is anchored with DepEd Order No. 35, s. 2016 entitled “The Learning Action Cell as a K to 12 Basic Education Program School-Based Continuing Professional Development Strategy for the Improvement of Teaching and Learning,” this Office reiterates the conduct of School Learning Action Cell (SLAC) every 1st Friday of the month, 3:00 – 5:00 PM.

 - e. Classroom Structuring
 - f. Personality Development of Teachers
 - g. Beautiful Schools
 - h. Child Protection Policy
 - i. Utilization of MOOE
 - j. Oral and Written Communication Enhancement
3. School Heads shall submit their training design two weeks before the conduct of SLAC and a quarterly accomplishment report of the SLAC shall also be submitted, Attention: Carmelita A. Jubay, CID Chief.
