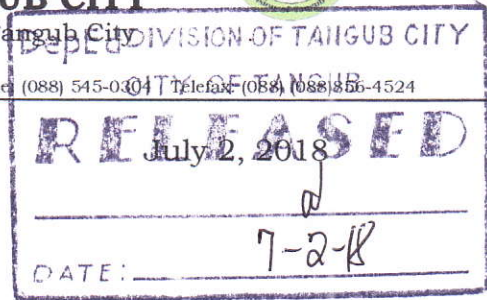

**PARTICIPATION TO THE MISAMIS OCCIDENTAL GIRL SCOUT  
COUNCIL 4-DAY LIVE-IN TROOP LEADERS TRAINING**

To: **All Elementary & Secondary School Heads & GSP Coordinators**

1. Scouting with the Girl Scouts of the Philippines (GSP) is an effective co-curricular program in the leadership and value formation of every child. The main objective of this Non-formal Education Program of the GSP is consistent with the Departments mission to enhance, support and develop girls and young women into well-rounded individuals with exemplary character.
2. With its impressive track record on youth development, the DepEd recognizes GSP as a partner in the holistic development of each girl and young women into responsible and responsive citizens of the country. As a co-curricular program, the activities of the GSP helps stem away vices and bad influences of drugs and peers.
3. To fully equip our teachers with the necessary knowledge and skills which are vital to their function as leaders in Girl Scouting activities and pursuant to the approved Misamis Occidental Girl Scout Council Circular No. 01 and 02 series of 2018, **this office calls for teacher participants** to the 4-day live in Troop Leadership Training of Twinklers (Pre-School); Star Scouts (Grade I-III); Junior Girl Scouts (Grade IV-VI); and Senior/Cadet Girl Scouts (High School/ Senior High School) who are physically fit on July 7-8, 2018 and July 14-15, 2018 at Ozamiz City School of Arts and Trades, Ozamiz City.
4. The registration fee is Four Hundred Pesos (400.00) to cover the cost of training certificates, ID, donations for the venue, and other incidental training expenses may be charged to school scouting funds, PTA funds, funds sourced from other stakeholders/ personal funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.



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5. Participants are to take care of their own meals and snacks for the whole duration. There is canteen in the school.
6. Participants are to bring the following: a) Girl Scout uniform; b) Semi Formal Attire; c) Personal medicines (if any); d) Writing materials; e) toiletries and personal effects; and f) Sleeping materials if they want to sleep in the school.
7. Participants to this training are entitled to 4 days service credits supported by Daily Time Record pursuant to DepEd Order No. 86, s. 2012 entitled Guidelines on Revitalizing Girl Scouting in Schools Nationwide which reiterates DECS Memorandum No. 143, s. 1997 provides that service credits shall be granted for attendance in scouting activities.
8. Confirmation of Teacher Participants shall be submitted to the Division Office thru Mr. Arniel B. Mehoy, PDO-I, Division GSP Coordinator on or before July 5, 2018 (Thursday).
9. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is highly enjoined.
