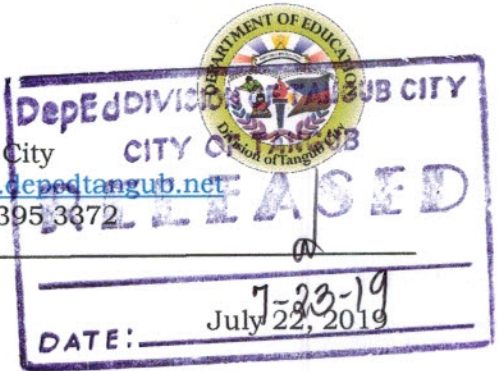

**DIVISION – WIDE MASS TRAINING OF GRADE – I TEACHERS ON
MULTI – FACTORED ASSESSMENT TOOL (MFAT)**

1. In response to DepEd Order No. 29 S. 2018, Department of Education, Division of Tangub City through the Curriculum Implementation Division(CID), schedules the **Division – wide Mass Training of Grade – I Teachers on Multi – Factored Assessment Tool (MFAT)** on August 1 – 3, 2019 at Function Hall – I, Tangub City
2. This is a classroom activity – based assessment covering the five domains of learning: a) cognitive, (b) communication (c) socio – emotional, (d) psycho – motor, and (e) daily living skills. It assesses Grade – I learners enrolled in regular schools who may exhibit developmental advancement, delays or have manifestations of learning disability.
3. MFAT aims to:
 - a. Identify learners with Special Educational Needs (LSENS), may need education services/or medical/ allied services
 - b. Assist teachers in planning and designing instructions
 - c. Strengthen inclusive education
 - d. Early reading intervention
 - e. Develop and produce contextualized instructional materials
4. Participants of this training are all grade one teachers, this division with a registration fee of Six Hundred Fifty Pesos (600.00) charge to School MOOE/Local Funds to cover lunch and snacks for 3 days subject to usual accounting, auditing roles, policies and regulations.
5. Teachers are requested to bring with them localized teaching – learning reading resources for beginning readers for a contest of gallery display by district. Winners will receive certificate of recognition for most numbered quality and developmentally appropriate group innovation of resources.
6. School Heads are directed to take over the classes or available teachers in the absence of the Grade – 1 teachers.
