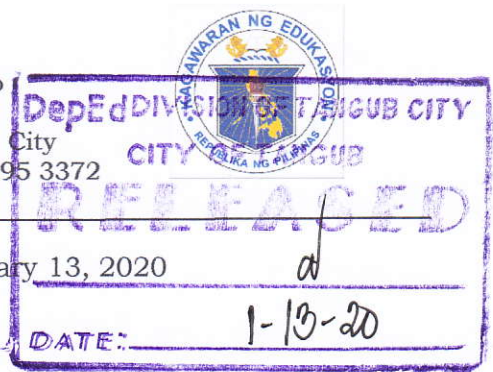

<p><b>Guidelines:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Participants shall be the officially enrolled grade 8 students who were under Information Communication and Technology (ICT) as major on their Technology and Livelihood Education (TLE) Subject.</li> <li>2. Schools are required to prepare and present a photocopy of SF2 or the Daily Attendance Report of Learners for reference.</li> <li>3. The subject or theme of the layout shall be given during the contest proper.</li> <li>4. Each school may use any software at their own convenience.</li> <li>5. Size of the canvass shall be 4 feet x 8 feet with a resolution of 72 pixels per inch.</li> <li>6. The tarpaulin must contain the Division and School Logo.</li> <li>7. Each school must prepare their own raw materials to be used in the layout.</li> <li>8. Only the Judges and the contestants are allowed inside the venue during the contest proper.</li> <li>9. Winners will be announced through a Division Memorandum.</li> <li>10. The decision of the board of judges shall be final, non-negotiable and irrevocable.</li> </ol>
